Numbers On The Move



• Guess My Number

- o Pick a number within a range of numbers your child is learning
- Tell your child the range and have him or her start guessing what number you picked
- With each incorrect guess, give them another clue, i.e. "my number is less than that" or "my number is two more than that" or "my number is an odd number," etc.

• How Many, How Many

 As you are walking around, driving to do errands, etc., ask your child to count items he or she sees: steps on the playground ladder, number of people walking down the street, how many blue towels are in a stack, the six oranges you are buying at the grocery store, etc.

Number Treasure Hunt

- While home or out, have your child pretend he or she is on a treasure hunt
- Look for numbers around you, and discuss how the number is used (i.e. to tell the cost of an item for sale on a store sign, to describe the date or time on a billboard describing when an event will be held, etc.)
